

### **Publications & Award**

In 2024, APAEM members have produced an extensive list of research papers in reputable international journals, such as *Journal of Business and Economic Statistics, Journal of Consumer Psychology, Journal of Financial Econometrics, Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Research, Journal of International Economics, Macroeconomic Dynamics, Management Science, Nature,* and *The Innovation*.



Prof. Du Li, a member of the APAEM Smart Tourism Team, along with his doctoral student Wang Zhangyu, published a commentary article titled "To unlock mutual benefits, don't restrict US—China genome data transfer" in the prestigious science journal, *Nature*. The article highlighted the regulatory challenges of data sharing and cooperation in genomics research between China and the United States.

The paper titled "Rethinking Metaverse Tourism: A Taxonomy & An Agenda for Future Research," co-authored by Prof. Ye Wang of the APAEM Smart Tourism Team and Prof. Fiona Yang of FBA, received the Best Paper Award of the Year 2023 from *the Journal of Hospitality & Tourism Research* (SSCI, Q1).




# **Social Impact**

APAEM does not only dedicate to producing high-quality scientific research, but also actively engages in interviews and discussions on topics related to local and national policies. By participating in these dialogues, APAEM's researchers play a crucial role in bridging the gap among academia, policymakers, and the public.



Prof. Angus Chu, team leader of Asian Economics team, conveyed his optimism about the "Macau Consumption Grand Prize" initiative in an interview with *The Macau Daily Times*.







Prof. Sili Zhou, Asian Economics team member of APAEM, shared insights on the new retirement age policy during a panel interview conducted by the China Global Television Network (CGTN) *World Today*. He emphasized that the policy aims to optimize human resource utilization and meet the diverse needs of the population.

Moreover, the research of Asian Economics team has made prominent policy impact. Prof. Inácio BÓ, team member of Asian Economics team, has co-developed a new approach that applies economic principles to enhance the fairness of the university admission process in Brazil.

The approach was officially adopted as a law in Brazil, leading to significant adjustments to the affirmative action policies implemented by public federal universities. The approach co-developed by Prof Bó has become the official process used in Brazil's centralized university admissions system (Sisu), where 1.2 million students across the country compete for about 260,000 places in public universities.
